Day 01 – Tapas Tour


In a Magic Place

Day 01 – Submarino Restaurant

After unveiling Valencia we suggest having dinner at the Oceanographic, with its spectacular architecture, was designed by Félix Candela.

The restaurant is divided into two floors. The upper floor is arranged as a central island surrounded by park lake. This spacious ring known for its spectacular lamp, which, like a lily, illuminates the most special evenings, making your dinning experience simply unforgettable.

Regarding the lower floor of the restaurant is surrounded by a stunning aquarium inhabited by banks silver fish, which allows you to find a harmony between nature and gastronomy.

Day 02 - Albufera Park Activity

We will start our visit to the magnificent Museo Fallero. It houses the collection of Ninots, the satirical images of people and events burned every year during the Fallas festival which is the most important cultural activity in town

But the aim of this visit is the nature park known as Parque Natural de la Albufera which is only 15 km South of Valencia.

Day 02 – Contrapunto Restaurant

After appreciating the beauty of Albufera Park we shall have lunch at contrapunto. The design is a collaboration of interior design studio JanfriDesign with GGLAB. The interior space is organized around a dominating micro architecture and articulates the room.

It is a structure-sculpture built by braces natural wood, with a dual function, generate a spatial continuity between the exterior and interior of the restaurant as well as acoustically condition the Salo del Turia.

Day 02 - Cabrio Tour

For the afternoon enjoy a fabulous ride in convertible cars along the countryside of Valencia and Castellon Provinces.


Day 03 – La Duna
